- H. Reported matters: Achievements of Taiwan Open Government National Action Plan 2021-2024 (Report Unit: National Development Council)

- I. Discussed matters: Soliciting commitments of Taiwan Open Government National Action Plan (2025-2028) and the subsequent promotion efforts (Report Unit: National Development Council)

Decision:

- I. Proposal of commitments of the next National Action Plan

- (I) The Ministry of Environment shall be responsible for conducting communication with the public and participation pertaining to climate change (energy, net-zero emissions, and adaptation) through an open government format.

- (II) The Preparatory Office of the Personal Data Protection Commission shall be responsible for information autonomy-enhancing transparency in the use of personal data in large government databases as well as undertaking the implementation of personal data protection.

- (III) The Ministry of Digital Affairs shall be responsible for taking inventory of existing capacities and creating consensus for the development of cross-departmental open data.

- (IV) The Hakka Affairs Council shall be responsible for

the promotion of Hakka youth policy proposals.

- (V) The Ministry of Education shall be responsible for overseeing university affairs with the freedom of information.
  - (VI) The Council of Indigenous Peoples shall be responsible for curbing the digital gap of indigenous peoples.
  - (VII) The Ministry of the Interior shall be responsible for implementing policies related to financial transparency of religious groups.
  - (VIII) The Ministry of the Interior shall be responsible for enhancing political donations transparency.
  - (IX) The Ocean Affairs Council shall be responsible for providing oceanic information to people engaging in maritime activities through the GoOcean Platform.
- II. The two proposals pertaining to the university affairs with freedom information undertaken by the Ministry of Education and policies on financial transparency of religious groups undertaken by the Ministry of the Interior shall be subject to subsequent discussions of task forces before the decision of incorporating them is made.
- III. The withdrawal of the proposal by the Central

Election Commission pertaining to the provision of diverse declaration channels to applying candidates and the search function on property declaration to members of the public was approved. The proposal will not be incorporated.

IV. Deputy Ministers of responsible ministries were requested to invite non-government organization representatives in taskforces, experts on relevant issues, and civil society to form the work groups. They are required to complete all discussion on the commitments before the end of November. Subsequently, they are also required to collaborate with the National Development Council in formulating the preface of the action plan, the promotion of existing effort and achievements of open government, and the development process of the action plan, thereby compiling a complete action plan which shall be reported to the 13th meeting of the Executive Yuan Open Government National Action Plan Taskforce and submitted to the Executive Yuan.
